

A Perfect Scoresheet

On the back side is an example of a “perfect” scoresheet. Yes, I realize that it is typed and few people write that neat. We do want the scoresheets to be legible but the more important aspect is the information and layout of the scoresheet. A few things to note....

You will lose a bonus point(s) if the following items are not completed for EVERY match:

- 1) Player name and number
- 2) Total Innings
- 3) Total Points
- 4) No Defense marked when it was played
- 5) Total Points / Score
- 6) Match points earned
- 7) Total team points at the bottom
- 8) Table size (extremely important when not on a bar box)

We now track several statistics / patches on member services. If you want this to reflect on your record please make sure that the scorekeeper wrote in a hash for 9OS/9BR if you earned it. All other statistics are automatically calculated and it isn't necessary for you to write these on there. Do NOT put anything extra on the scoresheet where the scores are kept, use the message area.

“Other team kept score” should be written in the middle games section if your team did not observe and score the match. This is usually done when matches run late and are split. However we still need the player number/name, innings, defense, total points and match points copied over.

Player numbers are vital! You can skip leading zeros but must start the player number with the first whole number. i.e. 00901 can be written as “901” but 10901 must be written as “10901”.

Nine ball to finish the match sometimes earns the player one more point than what they need. In the total points section ONLY write down what they needed. i.e. a player finished with 47pts, he only needed 46. Write **46** in the total points block. Otherwise the computer kicks it out which will result in a match not being scored correctly.

Please total your defensive shots for EACH player, even if it is zero. Also try to keep some open area here for us to make notes of differences between yours and your opponents scoresheet.
